

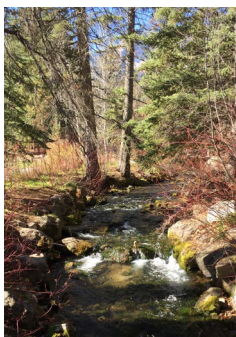
Dinner is at your leisure in one of the restaurants on site or cozy up in your room with the Sundance Channel.

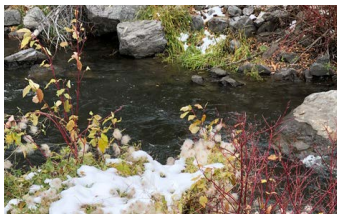


WEDNESDAY, NOVEMBER 1ST

Enjoy private accommodation for five nights of fun, art making, restorative practices, delicious food, and wine, surrounded by the beautiful Timpanagos Mountains and in the company of like-minded artists.

Balance is due by August 30th.

Price includes, five nights, six days at Sundance Resort, airport transfers to and from SLC, welcoming aperitif, three dinners, one meal voucher, daily continental breakfast, art studio with a fireplace to paint in, art materials for journal making project, daily yoga, art instruction, taxes, and most gratuities. Price does not include airfare.

Additional offerings available include jewelry, ceramics and soap making classes as well as full spa services but are not included in the workshop price.

MEET YOUR INSIDER

NANCY WILLIS

Artist Nancy Willis lives and works in the Napa Valley, an area known for its food, wine and natural beauty. As a painter and printmaker, Willis works with themes that explore intimacy and human connection and evoke a sense of place. She often uses scenes from her daily life as motifs in her paintings.

Her work has been featured at the Start Up Fairs in Houston, LA and San Francisco and exhibitions in Brooklyn, Albuquerque and Cincinnati. In 2022 Willis presented From This Moment On, an exhibition that was her response to the devastating effects of the Glass Fire on her neighborhood. Willis teaches painting and printmaking at the Napa Valley College and Nimbus Arts. She successfully launched Path of an Artist painting tours to France in 2007 and expanded the workshops to Sundance in 2009. Her recent addition is a coastal glamping getaway to Mendocino.

Her workshops at Sundance are an integral part of Willis' portfolio of curated experiences that give artists creative nourishment within the company of like minded artists.





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
